Driving Directions

The hotel is located centrally in Madison, right off the Beltline. For an online map, see http://www.mapquest.com/maps/706+John+Nolen+Drive+madison+wi/

The hotel entrance is immediately on your right as you enter John Nolen from the Beltline Highway at the lighted intersection of Rimrock Road and John Nolen Drive. There is plenty of parking on-site.

From Minneapolis Take I-94 E into Wisconsin

In the Madison area, I-94 E becomes I-39 S/I-90 E.

Take exit 142A to W Beltline Hwy/US-12 W/US-18 W toward Madison.

Take exit 263 to merge onto John Nolen Dr

The hotel is located almost immediately on your **right** once you have entered John Nolen (at the lighted intersection with Rimrock Road).

From Michigan/Illinois

Take I-90 W (past Chicago)

Take exit 142A on the left to merge onto W Beltline Hwy/US-12 W/US-18 W toward Madison

Take exit 263 to merge onto John Nolen Dr

The hotel is located almost immediately on your **right** once you have entered John Nolen (at the lighted intersection with Rimrock Road

From Iowa

Take US-151 N into Wisconsin Take the ramp onto **W Beltline Hwy/US-12 E/US-14 E/US-151 N/US-18 E** Take exit **263** to merge onto **John Nolen Dr** The hotel is located almost immediately on your **right** once you have entered John Nolen (at the lighted intersection with Rimrock Road).
